sincerely rescripted is a project of A Mused Collective, developed to explore the relationship between literacy and movement through the lost art of letter writing. sincerely rescripted workshops are developed in collaboration with Public Dance Acts (PDA).

Project Detail Summary

sincerely rescripted will explore human connection and communication through music, art, dance and writing. We are activating community involvement to help direct the creative process through a letter-writing campaign and community workshops. We are asking people to share letters with us that they have written or received. We are using the letters to guide our creative process as we choreograph movement and compose music. The letters will be more than creative fodder, they will be the impetus for meaningful communication with members of our community and an entry point for a community-generated exploration of literacy.

Project Goals

1. Promote literacy for all ages by exploring letter writing and engage with our local and global community on a creative, artistic and meaningful level.
2. Utilize the experiences of our community to create and share performance art, and document the project's development.
3. Facilitate letter writing and initiate a dialogue on literacy and the relationship to creative movement in our communities.
4. Establish collaborative relationships with artists, dancers and musicians of all genres to encourage a mutually beneficial and vibrant network.
5. Develop an archive of the letters submitted for this project for future artists and generations.

Collaboration Opportunities for Artists

- **Create a performance art piece, physical art or a multi-media art installation based on letters you have written or received.**
 - A Mused Collective will be producing a low-tech performance series to provide an opportunity for collaborative artists to share their own work in progress.
 - Scheduled performance dates will be available by Spring 2013.
 - We encourage artists to submit their written and received letters to the sincerely rescripted archive, however this is not a requirement for participation.
 - Artists will not receive compensation but will be provided basic production support (lights, sound and stage management assistance).

 - Workshops that meet the following criteria will be promoted on our sincerely rescripted project website, listed on the project calendar and will be promoted by A Mused Collective and project collaborators reaching an audience of 600+ supporters.
 - The workshop needs to include one or more of the following components: letter writing, letter reading and creative art or movement inspired by letters or the letter writing process.
 - We request that workshops are free or low cost to allow open community access.
 - Limited financial support for facility rentals may be available by A Mused Collective on an as needed basis. A detailed project budget must be submitted prior to consideration.
